

Again, read **Romans 10:17** ***“So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”*** I recommend that you take the picture of the cross and laminate it as a working tool. Then go to the list of emotional trials in this book and find the one that describes your problem. The scriptures are to become your promise! On the left side of the cross under the word **MIND** list the scriptures for your emotional trial. These are to become the “sperm” if you will, to impregnate your measure of faith given to each new born Saint. Every day and as often as possible during the day, read these scriptures. When you pray, as often as you pray, you should pray the scriptures back to the Father. You pray until the Word is real on the right side of the cross or your emotions are in agreement with the Word of God! Yes, for several days and or weeks, it will seem redundant, but keep on reading. Look at Hebrews 6:12 ***“...imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promise.”*** Note that the word patience means “fortitude” in the Greek. This means to keep on reading especially when everything seems to tell you to quit! The definition of the word “faith” is “an applied confidence in God and His Word”. When we read the word we read with a confidence in the Word that it means what it says and we read it with the fortitude of daily praying even when the enemy is telling you that it will not work!

As you read the Word and pray the Word, you are hearing the Word. The more you read and hear the Word of God the more you are seeding into your measure of faith. How long must I read the Word and pray the Word? Well, we are to read the word of God until a faith child of promise is conceived! And once conceived it will give birth to ***YOUR FAITH CHILD OF PROMISE!***

One day you think you are going to read the Word once again, but you will suddenly realize that instead of the reading from your mind, you will be stating that promise out of your spirit! Your **FAITH CHILD OF PROMISE** has been born as you fully realize that the promise has come to pass.
